Quality and Excellence

RPT Code of Practice

- 1. Quality of work must be maintained
- 2. Safe working practices are followed as set out in RPT Form 13, Advisory Guidance Notes for Workshops
- 3. Execution of work when demonstrating or teaching must adhere to safe working practices (see RPT F13).
- 4. Certificate of Public and Products Liability Insurance must be held if undertaking commercial work (ie selling, teaching or demonstrating)
- 5. Encouraged to hand out Demonstration and Teaching feedback forms
- 6. Must adhere to health and safety standards (as set out in the HSE Guidance)
- 7. Agree to comply with the disciplinary policy and procedure (RPT Form 8)
- 8. Agree to comply with the complaints policy and procedure (RPT Form 9A)
- 9. Any member demonstrating at clubs, woodworking shows or events should always do so using best practice
- 10. Show an intent to responsibly source materials (ie FSE approved sources)
- 11. Encouraged to charge an hourly rate that does not undercut other turners
- 12. Charge sensible rates for demonstrations and teaching.
- 13. You are expected to conduct yourself in a respectful way on Social Media.
